Dedicated VoipNow Professional plans target technically skilled customers or enterprises that are able to set and manage the VoIP system on their own.

Smaller Internet telephony service providers also prefer to lease the entire platform they conduct business on. Such providers can rent a virtual or a dedicated server, depending on the number of users they plan to deploy with the installation.
